## Recognition

- **Homes**
  - In 2009, Touchmark at Mt. Bachelor Village received national acclaim from the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB). Touchmark’s Cliff Lodge and Terrace Lodge were named **Best Independent Living Community** and received a gold award (the highest given) at the Best of 50+ Housing Awards. Jurors stated, *“This is not only a beautiful example of regional architecture but a great community ... All aspects of the project are of high quality and finish with units maximizing views and common areas maximizing function.”*
  - Touchmark at Mt. Bachelor Village was the 2005 recipient of the National Association of Home Builders’ **Best of Seniors Housing Award**. The community received the platinum award—the highest recognition—in the “for-sale condominiums” category. Jurors’ comments were: *“The jury would like to live here! Fantastic contrast of heavy timber framing and extensive use of glass and metal. The use of stone and wood ties the building to its sloping site. The meandering stream further enhances the site. This project proves that high density development can be done with sensitivity and environmental compatibility.”*
- **Life Enrichment/Wellness**
  - In 2009, Touchmark at Mt. Bachelor Village received one of the first Annual Senior Leadership Awards by the Oregon Governor’s Council on Physical Fitness and Sports. The award is based on exemplary leadership and achievement in senior programming and enrichment.
  - In 2008, the Health Promotion Institute—a part of the National Council on Aging—presented Touchmark with a Best Practice award for its Let Your Spirit Soar campaign, a component of the Touchmark Full Life Wellness & Life Enrichment Program.
- **Touchmark’s Fall Reduction and Awareness Program**  
Touchmark was one of 10 national programs identified in 2007 by the Falls-Free Coalition for creative programs and practices in home assessment and modification that can reduce home hazards.
